



## Ford Piquette Avenue Plant Privately Owned Vehicle Storage Policies

- Storage is for long-term/seasonal storage, not for ongoing repairs or projects
- Advance billing occurs quarterly; lease document provided
- Pricing is \$125 per month for spaces with unobstructed ingress/egress; \$75 for parked-in vehicles, if multiple vehicles
- Current owner registration and insurance are required. Insurance must include comprehensive coverage (fire, theft, vandalism). The Ford Piquette Plant does not provide any insurance coverage on privately owned vehicles.
- Cars may be started to immediately exit the building, but they may not idle inside the building.
- Storage for vehicle trailers or tow vehicles is not permitted in the parking lot.
- No volatile liquids are allowed to be stored in the vehicle or the building. Volatile liquids must be removed from the building. This includes rags or towels that may have been exposed to volatile liquids.
- Batteries must be disconnected during storage.
- Vehicles must be drained of gas for winterization, or gasoline valves turned off. Cars without gasoline valves require special arrangements.
- Vehicle covers are recommended if dust is a concern.
- Vehicle owner must provide protection for oil drips from the vehicle as required from the engine or rear end. Fire extinguishers are provided. You may not remove any fire extinguisher from the building. You must report to the office if any fire extinguisher is used.
- A fob for the parking lot entrance gate is available for vehicle access in the office during business hours, or via a lock box by prior arrangement. Tenants will receive a key to the lock on the storage bay doors. Tenants can park in the museum lot, enter through the man gate, and then exit the parking by pulling up to the automatic gate.
- Accessing stored vehicles outside of museum business hours is by appointment only.
- Storage is for vehicles only.
- Failure to follow any of the above requirements may lead to immediate dismissal without refunds.
